Aim to complete your bachelor's degree, a prerequisite for officer candidacy, and begin the process of applying to Officer Candidate School (OCS) with necessary documents, references, and preparations for upcoming interviews and assessments.

Apply for Pilot Training - With a bachelor's degree and officer status, individuals can now apply for Undergraduate Pilot Training (UPT). This involves another set of applications, medical examinations, and aptitude tests.

Maintain Good Performance and Conduct Records -

Enlisted members aspiring to be officers should ensure they have a strong military performance record, which will be considered during the officer selection process. Attend Officer Candidate
School (OCS) - If accepted,
enlisted members will attend
OCS (duration varies but
typically ranges between 12
to 17 weeks), where they will
undergo physical training and
classroom instruction.

If accepted into Undergraduate Pilot Training (UPT), anticipate a year of intensive pilot training, encompassing ground school and flight lessons. Post UPT graduation, newly minted pilots will be assigned to a specific aircraft and will undertake additional, type-specific training.
